

 Green Mark	<b>Recycled Office Automation Paper</b>	No. 2
		Category No. A-01
<b>1. Scope</b> This standard applies to paper made from recycled paper (“product”) and used for copying or printing purpose.		
<b>2. Terms and definitions</b> For this standard, the following terms and definitions shall apply. <b>(1)</b> FSC certificate: the Chain of Custody (CoC) certificate issued by the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC); <b>(2)</b> PEFC certificate: the Chain of Custody (CoC) certificate issued by the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC). <b>(3)</b> PEFC-recognized national forest certificate: the Chain of Custody (CoC) certificate issued by a national forest certification system with PEFC’s mutual recognition.		
<b>3. Product characteristics</b> 3.1 The product shall contain at least 60% recycled paper. 3.2 If virgin pulp is used in the product, only FSC or PEFC certified virgin pulp shall be used. 3.3 The product’s additives and surface coating materials shall not contain hazardous substances assigned the following hazard statements by the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS): H317, H340, H341, H350, H351, H360, H361, H400, H410, H411, H412, and H413. The applicant shall provide a complete list of product’s additives and surface coating materials and associated safety data sheets (SDSs) for review. The SDS shall contain the ingredients’ names, CAS Nos. and applicable GHS hazard statements.		
<b>4. Packaging</b> The materials of the product packaging shall meet the requirements of the <i>Guidelines on Review of Applications for Qualified Environmental Protection Products</i> .		
<b>5. Labeling</b> 5.1 The name, address and consumer hotline of the Green Mark user shall be clearly printed on the product or packaging. 5.2 Product or product packaging shall bear a label indicating the content of domestic-sourced recycled paper. For imported products, the label shall read "Imported Recycled Paper Product". 5.3 The product or product packaging shall also bear a label reading "Made of XX% Recycled Paper" and “Conservation of Forestry Resource”.		
<b>6. Other requirements</b> Products are considered the same if they differ only in size and packaging.
